Guidelines on Preparation for the Constitution of Student Societies

The constitution of a student society registered under the Co-curricular Support Office shall include the following sections:

- 1 Name of the Student Society
- 2 Objectives the purposes for which the society is formed
- 3 Session the year
- 4 Membership
 - 4.1 Types of membership (and membership number if applicable)
 - 4.2 Terms of admission of members
 - 4.3 Privileges and rights (e.g., entitlement to vote in a general meeting and hold office)
 - 4.4 Membership fee (if applicable)

5 Organization Structure

- 5.1 Outline the overall organization structure of the society
- 5.2 Quorum and procedures for calling an Annual General Meeting, Extraordinary General Meeting and General Meeting
- 5.3 Election procedures e.g., nomination procedure and period of office, conditions of legal/effective vote
- 5.4 Executive Committee and subcommittees (if applicable) positions, roles/responsibilities

6 Finance

- 6.1 Funding/financial sources
- 6.2 Budget
- 6.3 Annual report and auditing

7 Penalty, Resignation and Dissolution

- 7.1 Handling of complaints and imposing of penalties in relation to the administration of the society
- 7.2 Procedures in dealing with resignation of office-bearers
- 7.3 Procedures for dissolution

8 Amendments

- 8.1 Procedures for making amendments to the constitution
- 8.2 Clear stipulation that members' endorsement (and other conditions, e.g., umbrella body, if applicable) is required before any constitutional amendments are adopted
